The 2019 Cabernet Sauvignon wasn't bottled at the time of my tasting, but it's certainly an impressive barrel sample. Coming from Atlas Peak, it offers some classic mountain blue fruits as well as notes of graphite and obvious minerality. Rich, full-bodied, and concentrated, it has plenty of tannins and a savory, complex style that will benefit from bottle age.

GROWING SEASON

The 2019 season brought above average rainfall with an unusually wet May, leading to fully saturated soils coming out of spring and lasting well into the summer. A warm August and cooler temps in September and October completed the near perfect growing season. Conditions allowed longer hang time, which promoted grape maturity in our mountain vineyards.

TASTING NOTES

The 2019 Aileron Cabernet Sauvignon is dark in color with explosive aromatics of mountain herbs, cedar, violets, chocolate, and graphite. On the palate, the wine is dense, full-bodied, and harmonious, punctuated by hints of black cherries, plums and warm spices mixed with toasty French oak. Tannins are refined and polished front to back, affording great tension and length. Drink now and enjoy for the next 15+ years.
